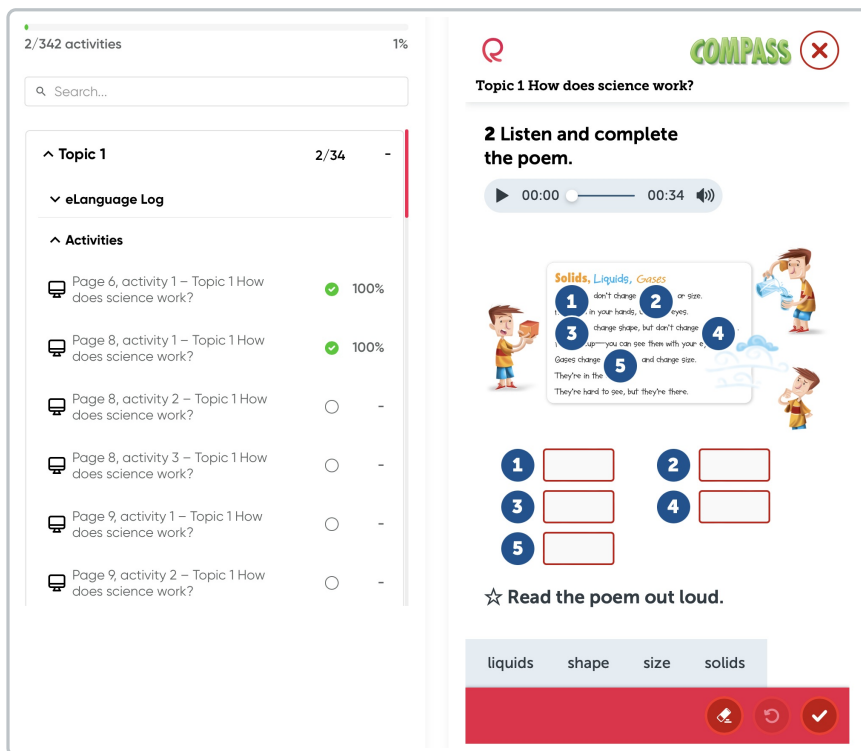
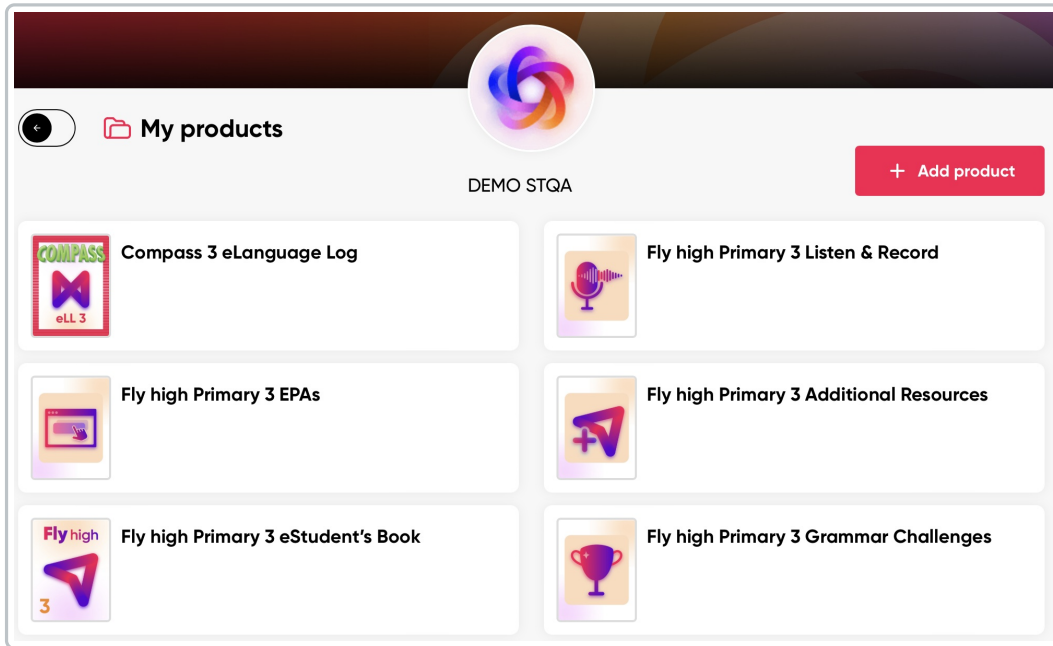

What is a code and where can I find it?

A Product Access Code is a combination of letters and numbers (e.g., RP4E5F678923) that refers to a product, such as a textbook. It is an alphanumeric code that can range from 12 to 20 characters (e.g., XX00-0X0X-00XX-0XX0) and appears on the inner page of the book's cover, on a card or sheet included with the purchased book, or provided by your institution. For digital products, it may be received via email or as part of the eCommerce purchase. An Access Code is required when you register on the Richmond Studio.
